

Overseas Pastors

Most of these men receive full personal support from the Tabernacle, together with support for all the listed branches of ministry. Most had training or pastoral refresher courses at the Tabernacle's London Reformed Baptist Seminary (LRBS). Eight also operate training programmes for pastors (in every case being the only doctrines-of-grace course in the region). Ten are also engaged in literature translation.

Church and outreaches with Sunday Schools, plus translation of booklets into Shona, also hardship and hunger aid.
