## Lifting of Coronavirus Restrictions on Public Worship

On Sunday 25th July our worship arrangements will change. Some restrictions will be removed, but others will remain in place for six weeks and then reviewed.

- Ground floor – we retain 1-metre social distancing and the wearing of face coverings.
- Galleries – no social distancing and face coverings optional.
- Hymn singing – following the recorded Lord's Prayer, all hymns will be sung with organ accompaniment.
- Hymnsheets will continue, also the retiring offering.
- Leaving the service will continue to be by direction to avoid crowding.
- Hand sanitising on entry to the Tabernacle will continue to be offered.
- Pews will be sanitised after the Sunday morning service.
- Test & Trace slips will no longer be required of people.
- Lunch facilities at the Tabernacle will continue to be limited to Sunday School staff until new arrangements are announced.
- Current Morning School arrangements will continue.
- We must urge any who feel unwell with a high temperature, a new continuous cough or a loss or change to their sense of smell or taste, not to come to services until tested.
